However, there have been already other serious incidents triggered by the ever-growing demand for energy: the explosion of the BP oil platform "Deepwater Horizon" 2010 in the Gulf of Mexico; thousands of square kilometers of contaminated soil in Nigeria, where as much crude oil is seeping in the ground as in the Exxon Valdez accident in Alaska in 1999.

Can we fulfill the EU-2020-climate goals and quit the production of nuclear energy? What possibilities does the EU have to regulate nuclear energy?
